- Enhances collaboration among school personnel and parents in resolving children's behavior problems

Other available workshops include a parenting program and one that trains school personnel how use the INSIGHTS curriculum materials.



# Gains from INSIGHTS included: \

**INSIGHTS** has been tested in three federally funded randomized clinical trials. Our most recent study included schools that were randomized to INSIGHTS or to a reading program.

#### For children in INSIGHTS:

- Higher reading achievement
- Higher math achievement
- Greater sustained attention
- Fewer disruptive behavior problems

#### For INSIGHTS classrooms:

- More teacher emotional support of students
- Better classroom organization
- Better student engagement
- · Less student off-task behavior

#### For children with shy temperaments:

- Higher math skills
- Improved critical thinking
- More classroom engagement

## For children with high-maintenance temperaments:

- Better student-teacher relationships
- Fewer disruptive behavior problems
- More classroom engagement
- Less off-task behavior

#### For children with ADHD:

Successfully treats children with ADHD without the use of medication

### Long-term effects:

- Fewer special education services
- Sustained language arts skills through 4th grade
