ENHANCING EMPATHY SKILLS

NEW INSIGHTS features four puppet characters who depict distinctive temperaments (personalities): Coretta the Cautious who is shy; Gregory the Grumpy who is high maintenance; Fredrico the Friendly who is very social; and Hilary the Hard Worker who is industrious, With the help of the NEW INSIGHTS characters, children learn that people have different temperaments that make some situations easy for them to handle while others are more challenging.



LEARNING HOW TO RESOLVE DILEMMAS

Videos of the **NEW INSIGHTS** characters demonstrate how to successfully self-regulate (or not!) when dilemmas occur. The characters are guided by a stoplight (**RED**: recognize a dilemma; **YELLOW**: think and plan; **GREEN**: try it not).



RESOLVING REAL-LIFE DILEMMAS

With the help of the **NEW INSIGHTS** characters and their teachers, students apply the same problem-solving process and self-regulation strategies to the dilemmas that they experience in their daily lives.

Each of the 10 weekly lessons includes videos, classroom mitten puppets depicting each of the characters, workbook sheets, vocabulary flashcards, and a digital dilemma board. A home-links app connects parents to the content and adds e-books to reinforce and expand upon the program's concepts.

OVERVIEW OF *NEW INSIGHTS* FOR CHILDREN KINDERGARTEN LESSONS



Each of the 10 weekly lessons includes classroom mitten puppets depicting each of the characters, videos, workbook sheets, vocabulary flashcards, and a digital dilemma board.

A Day in the Life of Fredrico the Friendly

Fredrico is excited because he is going to a birthday party. He wanders off in the store where he and his mother are buying a toy for his friend. Mom cautions him to be more careful. He has a wonderful time at the party interacting with all his friends.

A Day in the Life of Coretta the Cautious

Coretta also is invited to the birthday party. Unlike Fredrico, she is shy and cautious. Her friends help her engage with the other children.

A Day in the Life of Hilary the Hard Worker

Hilary gets involved in an art project, goes to the museum, and does her homework. She reviews her day with her mom at bedtime. In each situation, Hilary is a hard worker.

A Day in the Life of Gregory the Grumpy

Gregory engages in the same activities as Hilary did. His reactions to the situations, however, are different from hers. He needs frequent reminders to stay on-task.

Hilary Gets Her Feelings Hurt

Hilary encounters a dilemma when she tries to play with some children in the after-school program. The children tell her they don't want to play with her because they don't like her. Hilary's feelings are hurt. Her *NEW INSIGHTS* friends help her resolve her dilemma by using a stoplight and a dilemma board to think through possible solutions.

Gregory Is Annoying

Gregory rudely interrupts Coretta and Hilary when they are playing dress-up. Fredrico is enlisted to help the *NEW INSIGHTS* friends resolve their dilemma with Gregory.

Coretta Needs Her Teacher's Help

Coretta was sick when her teacher explained how to do the math sheet that she and her classmates are expected to complete. She needs help but is facing a dilemma trying to figure out how to get it.

Fredrico Wants Gregory To Come Play At His House

Fredrico invites Gregory to play at his house. Gregory's mom says he cannot go because she doesn't know Fredrico's mother.

Little Brothers: Another of Life's Dilemmas

Gregory is upset because his friend Jason's baby brother comes with them when they go to the park.

Fredrico Is Sad

Hilary asks Fredrico why he wasn't at Michael's party last Saturday. He says his grandfather died. The *NEW INSIGHTS* characters learn how to support their friends when they are sad.
